Footnotes:

1. The value of service is higher with new patients as more background information is required to optimally assess needs.
2. Wart management may be extensive and may best respond to a procedure, hence costs may vary.
3. Post-testing consultations are advised when some screening tests return positive and/or unexpected results.
4. Screening evaluations for blood pressure and blood glucose may benefit from multiple visits (e.g. three separate blood pressure readings provide a more accurate clinical picture), but are billed globally (one fee for all visits), without additional charges.
5. Biopsies take a portion of the lesion (circular punch biopsy) or all of the lesion (excisional) to be submitted for evaluation by a pathologist (latter charged separately).
6. Laceration, wound, and abscess management are notorious variable in presentation and complexity, hence the variation in global (one fee for all visits) charges.
